






Children will stand up in front of their friends and speak about topic that interest them or share something that they love. It builds confidence and helps children develop effective communication skills.




#### **Academic Development Programme (Upper Primary)**

#### On your Child's First Day

Your child will be given the Nascans orange sticker.

School class teacher will bring your child to the Nascans Meeting Point.

Attendance and temperature will be taken and your child will be brought for lunch

#### **Daily Arrival and Departure**



- Attendance taking upon arrival of children
- Departure recording will be done and child is only released to authorized person, as stipulated by parents.
- One staff will be in charge of accompanying children to the dismissal location.
- If the authorized person is unable to fetch the child, parent confirmation is sought to release the child to another person and the Centre will record the NRIC details of this person as an added precaution.




